## DAY 1

*Morning* Arrival at Munich Airport. Transfer to Munich city center (1 h\*)

#### Check in at the **LOUIS Hotel**

In the heart of the Munich city center, directly at the world-famous Viktualienmarkt, you will find the charming LOUIS Hotel.



#### Guided tour through Munich's old town

## DAY 2

*Morning* Transfer from Munich to Lake Chiemsee (1 h 30 m\*)

### Start of the German Alpine Road

### WELCOME TO LAKE CHIEMSEE!

**Lake Chiemsee** is the largest lake in Bavaria and lies in a picturesque Alpine foothill. It is not only the scenic beauty that makes it so attractive, but also the wide range of leisure activities that make it one of the most important sights in Germany.

#### Check-in to **Yachthotel Chiemsee**

Surrounded by lush nature, Yachthotel Chiemsee on the western shore of Bavaria's largest lake provides guests with the utmost relaxation.



#### Private tour of **Herrenchiemsee New Palace**

Royal palace built by King Ludwig II is known as the "Bavarian Versailles" as it was modeled after the Palace of Versailles built in honor of King Louis XIV of France.

*Afternoon*

#### Excursions in and around Lake Chiemsee

Take a boat ride across Lake Chiemsee or explore mountains Kampenwand, featuring the tallest summit cross of the Bavarian alps, or Wendelstein.

## DAY 3

*Morning* Transfer from Lake Chiemsee to Berchtesgaden (1 h 30 m\*)

**WELCOME TO BERCHTESGADEN!**  
**Berchtesgaden** is a wonderful mixture of unspoilt nature in Berchtesgaden National Park and a historical town centre that is perfect for strolling around.

Explore Berchtesgaden town center



**Visit Salt Mine Berchtesgaden**  
Deep below the surface of Berchtesgaden's "Salzberg" is a secret world waiting to be discovered. Highlights of the Salt Mine Berchtesgaden include the miner's slide, the train ride through the tunnels and the raft ride across a crystal-clear saline pool.



**Lunch at Gasthaus Reichenbach**  
The Reichenbach is located in the Salt Mine's former machinery building, which has been converted into an inn.



**Boat trip on Lake Königssee**  
The trip by e-boat to the pilgrimage church of St. Bartholomä leads you between steep mountain walls across what is probably Bavaria's most famous lake.

## DAY 4

*Morning* Transfer from Berchtesgaden to Garmisch-Partenkirchen (2 h 30 m\*)

**WELCOME TO GARMISCH-PARTENKIRCHEN!**

**Back to nature, back to your roots in Garmisch-Partenkirchen.** The varied landscape at the foot of the Zugspitze has lots to offer both in summer and in winter. On the slopes, during a mountain hike, or biking – the Bavarian Alps offer you countless opportunities to experience eventful moments.

Transfer from Garmisch-Partenkirchen to Zugspitze and ascend by cable car (20 m\*)



### Arrive Zugspitze, Germany's Highest Mountain

Enjoy tobogganing all year round and lunch at the restaurant with floor to ceiling windows offering delicious Bavarian dishes and incredible panoramic views of the Alps. At the foothills of the Zugspitze, walk along the picturesque lake Eibsee.

**Afternoon** Stroll through the towns of Garmisch and Partenkirchen, lunch at leisure



**Leisure time activities:**

- ★ Wamberg – highest church village in Germany

## DAY 5

**Morning** Transfer from Garmisch-Partenkirchen to Füssen (1 h 30 m\*)

### WELCOME TO FÜSSEN!

The attractive location of [Füssen](#) on the edge of the Alps with 800-1200 m above sea level, it's the town in Bavaria with the highest altitude. It is the ideal starting-point for trips to the royal castles of Neuschwanstein and Hohenschwangau, or the Wies Church.



**Füssen:**  
The town is over 700 years old and is the cradle of lute-making in Europe



**Guided tour of historic center of Füssen** with its Baroque churches, Gothic houses and medieval town walls.

**Afternoon** Transfer from Füssen to Schwangau (10 m\*)



**Visit and tour of Neuschwanstein Castle**

The castle was built for King Ludwig II between 1869 and 1886 on a rugged cliff against a scenic mountain backdrop, was intended to embody the true spirit of the medieval German castle.

Leisure time to explore Hohenschwangau Castle, Museum of Bavaria Kings or stroll around Lake Alpsee and village of Schwangau

## DAY 6

*Morning* Transfer from Füssen to Lindau (2 h\*)

### WELCOME TO LINDAU AT LAKE CONSTANCE!

Surrounded by a lush green environment and snow-covered mountains, lies the historic island of [Lindau](#) with its unique charm. With historic buildings, lively squares and picturesque alleys, the old town of Lindau provides a Mediterranean flair.



#### 3-country panoramic cruise on Lake Constance

See Bavaria's only lighthouse and Germany's southernmost lighthouse. This cruise on Lake Constance will provide beautiful views of 3 countries: Switzerland, Austria and Germany.



#### Lunch at Wissinger's im Schlechterbräu

The walls of the restaurant date back to the 14th century – the contrast between the modern interior of the inn and its fresh, regional cuisine.

*Afternoon*

#### Guided town center tour

Lindau island has an idyllic town center with narrow cobblestone and numerous Gothic, renaissance and baroque buildings. Visit Lindenhof Park with its art nouveau bath house, flowers and gardens.

*Evening*

#### Behind the scenes tour of Lindau's [Marionette Opera](#)

For over 20 years the Marionette Opera has been showing fantastic productions with lifelike looking and dancing puppets. It's Germany's only puppet theatre that performs operas, operettas and a ballet piece.

Overnight in Lindau at [Hotel Bayerischer Hof](#) with stunning views of Lake Constance
